The Howard Hughes Corp.'s Lakeland Village Center is an 84,000-square-foot mixed-use development within walking distance of Bridgeland, a master-planned community in Cypress. The \$20.5-million development includes dining, retail, professional services, medical offices and more. The retail center is meant to evoke a feeling of nostalgia in which customers stroll down a main street to shop, dine and mingle with friends and neighbors.

To preserve the aesthetics of the center, the developers located a majority of the parking to the back of the building. The retail center also has two custom murals painted by local artist Anat Ronet.

The Lakeland Village Center is the first of four planned commercial projects within the 11,400-acre Bridgeland master-planned community, located near the Grand Parkway and Highway 290.
